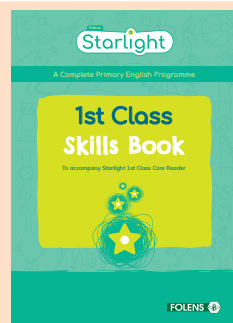
**Core Reader/ Foundation Reader** (Print)
