



QR codes

A QR code works in the same way as a barcode at the supermarket. A machine-scannable image can instantly be read using a smartphone camera.

Teachers can use QR codes to give students direct access to a website, a link, a video, a podcast, etc. It reduces the amount of time spent searching the internet for information. Students can access the web page or link at home or in school once they have the QR code.

Making a QR code is easy:

- **1.** Select the link you wish to copy.
- 2. Search for a free QR code generator such as QR Code Monkey.
- **3.** Follow the instructions.
- **4.** Scan this QR code to see how easy it is!

UPDATED INFORMATION

Family Law Act 2019

The Family Law Act 2019 amends existing laws in relation to divorce in Ireland:

- It amends Section 5 of the Family Law (Divorce) Act 1996 to reduce the minimum 'living apart' period specified in that Act to two years during the previous three years. It had previously been four years during the previous five years.
- The new Act gives statutory certainty to the interpretation
 by the Irish courts of the requirement for spouses to have lived apart for specified periods
 in order to be eligible to apply for judicial separation or divorce.
